Sports Channels

Sports fans will appreciate the Top 200's impressive roster of sports networks. You'll find all the primary ESPN channels (ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU, and ESPN Classic), Fox Sports 1 and Fox Sports 2, NBC Sports Network, and the Golf Channel. Importantly, the Top 200 includes **NFL Network** and **NBA TV**, which are often placed in higher tiers by other providers. You'll also get MLB Network, Tennis Channel, Outdoor Channel, and the Olympic Channel. While regional sports networks (RSNs) may vary based on your location, the core national sports coverage is very strong.

For die-hard fans, Dish offers add-on sports packages like NFL RedZone, MLB Extra Innings, NBA League Pass, NHL Center Ice, and various international sports packs. These can be layered onto your Top 200 subscription to create a customized sports viewing experience.

Entertainment and Lifestyle

The entertainment lineup in the Top 200 is extensive. You'll get the big general entertainment networks like TBS, TNT, USA Network, FX, AMC, Comedy Central, A&E, and Bravo. For reality and lifestyle fans, there's HGTV, Food Network, TLC, Discovery Channel, Animal Planet, History, and the Travel Channel. The package also includes channels like E!, MTV, VH1, and the Game Show Network. If you enjoy sitcoms and dramas, you'll have access to Turner Classic Movies (TCM), IFC, Sundance TV,

and more. The mix ensures that prime time is never boring.

News and Information

Staying informed is easy with the Top 200. This package includes the major 24-hour news networks: CNN, Fox News Channel, MSNBC, and HLN. For international coverage, you'll get BBC World News, CNBC World, and Bloomberg Television. Weather enthusiasts will appreciate The Weather Channel. If you want to go deeper, Dish offers optional news add-ons like Fox News International or select international news channels.

Kids and Family

Families with children will find plenty of age-appropriate content. The Top 200 includes Disney Channel, Disney XD, Disney Junior, Cartoon Network, Boomerang, Nickelodeon, Nick Jr., Nicktoons, TeenNick, and Universal Kids. PBS Kids is available in most local markets. Educational programming is also available through channels like National Geographic, the History Channel, and Discovery Family. Parents can use Dish's parental control features to lock certain channels or set viewing limits.

Movie Channels

While the Top 200 does not include premium movie networks (HBO, Showtime, Starz, Cinemax), it does offer several movie-centric channels: Turner Classic Movies (TCM), FXM (Fox Movie Channel), IFC (Independent Film Channel), and Sundance TV. You'll also get the SVOD-like access to Dish's on-demand library, which includes many recent movies at no extra cost.

Music Channels

Music lovers can tune into a wide array of audio channels from SiriusXM, Music Choice, and others. You'll find roughly 30 commercial-free music channels covering pop, rock, country, hip-hop, classical, jazz, and more. These are perfect for background listening or when you just want to hear your favorite genre.

How Does Dish Top 200 Compare to Other Packages?

Choosing the right Dish package depends on your viewing habits. Here's how the Top 200 stacks up against its siblings:

- **Dish Top 120:** The entry-level package with about 120 channels. It lacks many sports networks (no NFL Network, NBA TV, or Fox Sports 2) and some popular entertainment channels. It's a good budget option but skimps on variety.
- **Dish Top 120+:** Adds about 10 more channels than the 120, including a few regional sports networks and the Hallmark Channel. Still, the Top 200 offers a much broader selection of sports, news, and kids content.
- **Dish Top 250:** The top-tier package with roughly 250 channels. It adds premium movie channels like Max (formerly HBO Max) and Cinemax, along with a few extra sports and entertainment channels. If you watch a lot of movies or want the full DVR experience with no channel restrictions, the 250 might be worth the extra cost.
- **Flex Pack:** Dish's a la carte-style package. You start with

a base of about 60 channels and add "packs" for sports, news, lifestyle, etc. While flexible, it can become expensive if you add many packs, and it doesn't include the same depth of channels as the Top 200.

For the majority of households, the Top 200 provides the best balance of cost and channel count. You're getting nearly all the channels you actually watch without paying for ones you never tune into.

Add-Ons and Upgrades for Top 200 Subscribers

One of the best features of the Dish Top 200 is its upgradeability. While the base package is comprehensive, you can easily add premium channels and specialized packs. Popular add-ons include:

your Top 200 subscription. Options include Chinese, Vietnamese, Hindi, Arabic, Russian, and many other languages.

- **Multi-Sport & Hispanic Packs:** The Dish Latino packs blend Spanish-language entertainment with sports, and the "Multi-Sport" pack adds niche sports like cricket, rugby, and auto racing.

Each add-on integrates seamlessly with your existing Dish account and DVR, so you can record from any channel you add.
