Understanding Stats and Attributes

- **Lustgown:** Found in the Ruins. Great for lust-based strategies.
- **Phylactery:** Found in the Desert. Essential for mages to restore mana.
- **Minotaur Blood:** A transformative item found in the Wetlands. Use with caution—it increases strength and toughness but also libido.
- **True Aegis:** A shield available in Tel'Adre that provides excellent protection against magic.

Managing Your Corruption Level

This cannot be overstated: watch your Corruption score. While embracing corruption can unlock powerful demonic abilities and transformations, it also changes your character's personality and limits your options. If you want a "good" ending, keep your corruption below 50. Use **Holy Relics** and visit the **Church in Tel'Adre** to reduce it. The Glacial Rift is endgame content. The cold damage here is brutal. Equip frost-resistant gear. The final dungeon, the **Corrupted Castle**, is a gauntlet of elite enemies leading to Lethice herself. Before you enter, ensure your gear is fully upgraded and you have a full inventory of healing and restoration items.
