What is the Book of Excellent Teachings?

The **Book of Excellent Teachings** is a passive ability found in the Psijic Order skill line, introduced with the *Summerset* chapter. It is specifically designed to enhance the experience gains from deconstructing items at crafting stations. When you invest skill points into this passive, you receive a percentage increase to the Inspiration (crafting experience) earned each time you deconstruct an item.

This passive ability has multiple ranks, each offering a greater bonus. At its maximum rank, it provides a substantial boost, making it one of the most powerful tools in the game for rapidly advancing your crafting professions, including Blacksmithing, Clothing, Woodworking, Jewelry Crafting, and Enchanting.

It is important to note that this passive does not affect experience gained from crafting new items (creation) or from research. Its sole focus is the deconstruction process, which is already the primary method for leveling most crafting skills. By amplifying this primary source of experience, the Book of Excellent Teachings effectively cuts down the time and materials needed to reach the maximum crafting level.

Understanding the Psijic Order Skill Line

To access the Book of Excellent Teachings, you must first unlock and progress through the Psijic Order skill line. This skill line is tied directly to the *Summerset* chapter and the associated Psijic Order questline. The journey begins in Summerset, where you will encounter members of the order and embark on a series of quests that delve into the mysteries of time, space, and the enigmatic Psijic Order.

How to Unlock the Psijic Order Skill Line

The process begins by traveling to the Summerset island and starting the zone's main storyline. Early in this questline, you will meet a character named **Valsirenn**, who will initiate you into the Psijic Order. This unlocks the skill line at level 1. From there, you must complete a series of quests, known as the Psijic Order questline, to gain experience and level up the skill line. Each time you level up, you earn a skill point that can be invested in the various active and passive abilities it offers, including the Book of Excellent Teachings.

Leveling the Psijic Order Skill Line

Leveling this skill line requires completing the specific quests assigned by the order. These quests often involve traveling across Tamriel to close time breaches, solve ancient puzzles, and confront dangerous forces. It is a dedicated effort, but the rewards are well worth it. The Book of Excellent Teachings is not the only valuable ability in this skill line; others include the **Meditation** ability (which provides ultimate regeneration) and **Channeled Acceleration** (a powerful speed and minor force buff). However, for crafters, the Book of Excellent Teachings is the primary attraction.

Detailed Breakdown of the Book of Excellent Teachings

Let us examine the passive ability in greater detail. The Book of Excellent Teachings has three ranks, and each rank increases the experience bonus from deconstruction.

- **Rank I:** Increases Inspiration gained from deconstructing items by 10%.
- **Rank II:** Increases Inspiration gained from deconstructing items by 20%.
- **Rank III:** Increases Inspiration gained from deconstructing items by 30%.

This 30% boost at maximum rank is substantial. To put it into perspective, if deconstructing a specific item normally grants 100 Inspiration points, with the maxed-out passive, you will receive 130 points. Over the course of deconstructing hundreds or thousands of items, this bonus accumulates into a massive overall experience gain, effectively reducing the total number of items you need to deconstruct by nearly a quarter.

Which Crafting Skills Benefit?

The Book of Excellent Teachings applies to deconstruction in all the core crafting professions:

1. **Blacksmithing:** Deconstructing metal weapons and armor.
2. **Clothing:** Deconstructing cloth and leather armor.
3. **Woodworking:** Deconstructing staves, bows, and shields.
4. **Jewelry Crafting:** Deconstructing rings, necklaces, and other jewelry items (requires the *Summerset* chapter).
5. **Enchanting:** Deconstructing glyphs at an enchanting table.

It is important to note that while it applies to all these trades, the most dramatic effect is often seen in the first three (Blacksmithing, Clothing, Woodworking) because players typically deconstruct large quantities of gear obtained from quests, dungeons, and farming. Jewelry Crafting also benefits greatly, as jewelry is generally harder to come by and deconstructing it yields high experience per item.

What Does NOT Benefit?

To avoid confusion, it is worth noting what this passive does **not** affect:

- **Crafting (Creation):** Making new items, researching traits, or refining raw materials do not benefit from this passive.
- **Experience Points (Character XP):** This is not a bonus to character experience. It only affects crafting Inspiration.
- **Alchemy and Provisioning:** These trades do not involve deconstruction in the traditional sense. Alchemy uses solvents and reagents, and Provisioning involves recipes and ingredients. They have their own leveling paths.

Synergies and Optimal Strategies

The true power of the Book of Excellent Teachings is realized when it is combined with other experience-boosting mechanics. ESO offers several ways to further amplify crafting experience, and stacking these bonuses can result in explosive leveling sessions.

1. Enlightenment

While Enlightenment primarily affects character experience points (mounted by training), it does not directly affect crafting Inspiration. Therefore, do not rely on Enlightenment for crafting. However, you can use the time you save on crafting to focus on character leveling with an enlightened bonus.

2. Crafting Experience Scrolls and Potions

Items like **Psijic Ambrosia** or **Ambrosia** (crafted drinks) and **Experience Scrolls** (often obtained from daily login rewards or the Crown Store) can significantly boost your experience gains. It is critical to understand that most of these scrolls and potions boost **all** experience gains, including crafting Inspiration. When you activate a 150% experience scroll and deconstruct items with the Book of Excellent Teachings maxed out, you are effectively multiplying your gains. This is the most efficient way to level crafting skills.

3. Daily Crafting Writs

While deconstruction is the main driver, completing daily crafting writs also provides a large chunk of Inspiration. The Book of Excellent Teachings does not directly boost writ rewards, but by leveling your crafting skills faster through deconstruction, you unlock higher-tier writs sooner, which in turn yield better rewards and more experience.

4. Guild Membership and Skill Points

Ensure you have invested skill points into the passive abilities within each crafting skill line that increase deconstruction yield, such as **Metal Extraction**, **Unraveling**, and **Wood Extraction**. These passives not only improve the materials you get back but also increase the Inspiration gained from deconstruction. They stack multiplicatively with the Book of Excellent Teachings, creating a powerful synergy.

Why the Book of Excellent Teachings is Essential

For any player who intends to engage with the crafting system seriously, the Book of Excellent Teachings is not optional; it is essential. Here are the primary reasons why it should be a priority.

Accelerated Crafting Leveling

The most obvious benefit is speed. Without this passive, leveling a crafting skill to 50 (the maximum level) requires deconstructing a vast number of items. With the 30% boost, you can reach max level significantly faster. This is especially valuable for players who have multiple characters or who want to craft high-end gear for their endgame builds.

Resource Conservation

Because you need fewer items to reach the same experience thresholds, you conserve the resources that would have been used to create those items. This is particularly important for Jewelry Crafting, where raw materials (platings and grains) are expensive and rare. Deconstructing jewelry you find in the world or receive as quest rewards becomes much more efficient.

Improved Efficiency for Alt Characters

Players with multiple alt characters often need to level crafting on each one. The Book of Excellent Teachings, once unlocked, is account-wide in the sense that the passive ability can be used by any character who has leveled the Psijic Order skill line. While the skill line itself must be leveled on each character, the passive is incredibly powerful for each alt that completes the questline. Some players even consider it mandatory for their dedicated crafting characters.

Endgame Crafting and Master Writs

At the highest levels of crafting, you will be creating gear with multiple traits and using rare materials. High-level crafting requires a deep understanding of the system, and the Book of Excellent Teachings helps you get there faster. Additionally, earning master writs (special writs that reward vouchers) often requires having multiple crafting skills at maximum level. This passive directly accelerates that goal.

Practical Tips for Maximizing the Book of Excellent Teachings

To get the most out of this passive ability, consider the following practical strategies:

- **Save Your Items:** When you are actively leveling a crafting skill, do not deconstruct items one by one as you get them. Instead, store them in your bank or on a character. When you have a large stockpile (e.g., 100 or more items), activate an experience scroll or potion, and then deconstruct everything in one session. This maximizes the multiplicative bonus.
- **Focus on Intricate Gear:** Items with the **Intricate** trait provide a massive bonus to Inspiration when deconstructed. These items are invaluable for leveling. When you find intricate gear, always deconstruct it, especially while your experience boost is active. The Book of Excellent Teachings multiplies this bonus further.
- **Use the Correct Crafting Station:** Ensure you are deconstructing items at the correct station. A blacksmithing item must be deconstructed at a blacksmithing forge, etc. Using the wrong station will waste the item and grant no experience.
- **Consider Resourcefulness:** The **Resourcefulness** passive from the Psijic Order skill line also works well in conjunction with crafting, though it is separate from the Book of Excellent Teachings. It grants a chance to create a copy of a potion
