More importantly, you will need a reliable sword. The **Master Sword** is the obvious choice, as you will be playing as Adult Link for this entire segment. Ensure your sword is fully charged and ready for combat.

Additional Items for Success

- **Bombs:** You will need a good supply of Bombs to open cracked walls and defeat certain enemies. A full capacity of 20 or more is recommended.
- **Din's Fire:** While optional, Din's Fire can be incredibly useful for lighting torches in the Fire Temple and dealing with groups of enemies.
- **Fairy Potions:** Carry a few Red or Green Potions. The enemies inside the Crater and the Fire Temple hit hard, and having a backup heal is always wise.
