Where to Find the Components Easily

- **Paint Guns:** Check the Super Duper Mart in

Springvale. It is a reliable source for junk items.

- **Toy Cars:** The "Arefu" settlement has a few toy cars in the abandoned houses. Also, check the "Vault 101" overseer's office.
- **Surgical Tubing:** The "Megaton" clinic has one. Also, "Underworld" in the Museum of History has a clinic with abundant medical supplies.
- **Radscorpion Poison Gland:** Hunt Radscorpions near "Greyditch" or in the "Dunwich Building" area. A single gland is enough for one Dart Gun, but the schematics allow you to build multiple.

Best Uses and Strategies for the Dart Gun

The **Dart Gun** is not a primary weapon for dealing damage. Its value is purely tactical. Here are the best situations to use it:

1. Deathclaw Hunting

Deathclaws are the fastest and most lethal melee enemies in the game. A single shot from the Dart Gun will cripple their leg, reducing their speed to a crawl. You can then finish them off with a hunting rifle or a sniper rifle from a safe distance. This is the most classic use of the weapon.
