Local Channels

Your local broadcast channels (ABC, CBS, NBC, Fox, PBS, CW) are typically found in the single-digit or low double-digit range, often starting around Channel 2-13. Specific numbers depend on your market. Use the **Dish Network channel guide list** to find exactly where your locals are.

Regional Sports Networks (RSNs)

Dish offers many regional sports networks (RSNs), but availability varies by location. Examples include **Bally Sports** channels, **NESN**, **YES Network**, and **SportsNet NY**. Check your local **Dish Network channel**

guide is for the exact channel numbers. These are often found in the 400–500 range.

International Channels

Dish has extensive international programming through its **DishLatino** and other language packages. You can find channels in Spanish, Hindi, Punjabi, Tagalog, Russian, French, and more.
