Sports Channels

Hampton Roads is a passionate sports region, and Cox delivers with an extensive sports lineup. Subscribers can enjoy ESPN, ESPN2, FS1, FS2, NBC Sports Network, NFL Network, NBA TV, MLB Network, NHL Network, and Golf Channel. For regional sports, Cox includes MASN (Mid-Atlantic Sports Network) for coverage of the Washington Nationals and Baltimore Orioles, as well as ACC Network for college sports. If you are a fan of local high school sports or regional college athletics, you will find coverage on channels like Cox 11 and select community access stations. Sports programming is highlighted in a dedicated section of the guide, making it easy to find live games and analysis shows.

Kids and Family Channels

Families with children will appreciate the dedicated kids' category. Channels such as Disney Channel, Disney XD, Cartoon Network, Nickelodeon, Nick Jr., PBS Kids, and Boomerang are all available. These channels offer age-appropriate programming, including animated series, educational shows, and movies. The Cox Contour guide allows parents to set parental controls, ensuring younger viewers only access approved content. You can also create a Favorites list for kids so they can easily find their preferred channels.

Premium Channels and Movie Packages

This tier typically offers 140 to 200 channels, providing a balanced mix of entertainment, news, sports, and kids' programming.

Contour Premier or Top-Tier Package

The premier package includes everything in the lower tiers plus

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premium channels like HBO, Showtime, Cinemax, and Starz. It also includes additional specialty and international channels. Subscribers at this level often get access to 4K programming and expanded on-demand libraries. If you want the full Cox experience without compromises, this is the package to choose.

Add-On Packs

Cox also offers à la carte add-on packs that let you customize your lineup. Options include the Sports Pack, which adds channels like NFL RedZone, MLB Strike Zone, and regional sports networks from other markets. There is also the International Pack, the Variety Pack, and the Premium Pack. These add-ons are reflected in your channel guide as soon as you subscribe, and they integrate seamlessly with the Contour interface.

The guide will display all relevant listings across live TV and on-demand. This feature is one of the most underutilized but valuable tools in the Cox guide.

Set Recordings and Reminders
