Questions About the Main Characters

- **What is Zidane's occupation?**
□ *Thief*
- **What is Vivi's primary concern?**
□ *His lifespan*
- **Who is the captain of the Lindblum Air Force?**
□ *Cid*
- **What is Garnet's real name?**
□ *Dagger*
- **Which character loves to eat?**
□ *Salamander (Amarant)* – though many assume it is Steiner, Amarant has a notable appetite.

Questions About Locations

- **What city is known as the "City of Eternal Night"?**
□ *Treno*
- **Where can you find the auction house?**
□ *Treno*
- **Which village is home to the Black Mages?**
□ *Dali*
- **What is the name of the flying continent?**
□ *Forgotten Continent*

Questions About Story Events

- **What object does Zidane steal from Garnet in the beginning?**
□ *Her pendant (or "Garnet's pendant")*
- **Who is the main antagonist of the first disc?**
□ *Queen Brahne*
- **What did Vivi discover in the forest near Dali?**
□ *That the Black Mages are manufactured*
- **What is the name of the ship that crashes at the beginning?**
□ *The Prima Vista*
- **What disease does Eiko's grandfather have?**
□ *He is not actually ill – it is a trick – but the correct answer is "He is fine" or similar. However, the game asks about the condition: answer "He's not sick."*

Miscellaneous Questions

- **What is the name of the card game popular in Gaia?**
□ *Quad Mist (though many fans call it Tetra Master)*
- **How many Moogles are there in the game?**
□ *This varies by version, but the quiz answer is "Many" or a specific number like "20+". In most playthroughs, the correct choice is "A lot."*
- **What does the "Ice Cauldron" do?**
□ *It is a synthesis item, but the quiz is about a trivia question: "What is the name of the weapon used by Beatrix?" Answer: "Save the Queen."*

Pro Tip: The quiz randomly selects 5 questions from the pool. If you answer all 5 correctly, you earn the ultimate reward: a **Ribbon** (prevents most status ailments). For 4 correct, you get a **Protect Ring**. For 3 or fewer, you receive a **Potion** or a **Phoenix Down**. You can retry the quiz by saving before speaking to Doctor Tot and reloading if you fail.

Rewards and Why They Matter

The **Ribbon** is one of the best accessories in Final Fantasy IX. It protects against nearly every negative status effect, including Confusion, Silence, Zombie, and more. Equipping it on Zidane or Garnet can be a lifesaver in boss fights. The **Protect Ring** is also solid, offering protection against Death and Petrify. If you are not aiming for perfection, even a **Phoenix Down** is useful, but why settle?

Strategy to Ace the Quiz Every Time

Here are some practical tips to ensure you never miss a correct answer:

- **Save before the quiz** – Use a save point or the Mooglee in Treno. If you get a question wrong, simply reload.
- **Read the questions carefully** – Some options are designed to trick you. For instance, a question about "What did Zidane find on the beach?" may have "A shell" and "A letter" as options – the answer is often "A letter."
- **Use a quick reference** – Keep this guide open on your phone or second monitor while playing.
- **Know the game's early plot** – The quiz covers up to the end of Disc 2 roughly, so events from Lindblum, Burmecia, and Cleyra are fair game.
- **Listen to in-game clues** – Some NPCs in Treno drop hints about the quiz questions. Pay attention to their dialogue.

Frequently Asked Questions About the FF9 Pop Quiz

Can I retake the pop quiz?

Yes, as long as you are still in Treno and have not progressed past the point of no return. You can retry by leaving the building and re-entering, or by reloading your save.

What happens if I answer all questions wrong?

Doctor Tot will laugh at you and you receive no reward. The game does not punish you otherwise, but you miss out on items.

Does the pop quiz affect the story?

No, it is entirely optional. However, it provides a fun way to test your memory and earn a top-tier accessory.
